Crochet Robin Chocolate Orange

Body:

With brown yarn:

Round 1: 6 dc into Magic Circle

Round 2: 2dc into each stitch (12 stitches)

Round 3: 1dc into first stitch, 2dc into next stitch, repeat to end (18 stitches)

Round 4: 1dc, into first two stitches, 2dc into next stitch, repeat to end (24 stitches)

Round 5: 1dc into first three stitches, 2dc into next stitch, repeat to end (30 stitches)

Round 6: 1dc into first four stitches, 2dc into next stitch, repeat to end (36 stitches)

Round 7-11: 1dc into each stitch (36 stitches)

Change to Red

Round 12-17: 1dc into each stitch (36 stitches)

Round 18: 1dc into first four stitches, dc2tog, repeat to end (30 stitches)

Round 19: 1dc into first three stitches, dc2tog, repeat to end (24 stitches)

Round 20: 1dc into each stitch (24 stitches)

The wings:

6dc into magic circle **do no join together! Turn your work.**

2 dc in each stitch (12 stitches). Turn

2 dc into each stitch, but missing last stitch (22 stitches). Turn

1dc into each stitch, but missing last stitch (21 stitches)

Fasten off

To attach the wings, spread the wing out so the 'V' lies flat along the join of the red and brown on the body. Whip stitch along with brown yarn and secure on the inside of the body. It will be a bit fiddly, but

The beak:

Chain 6

Dc into each stitch (6 stitches). Turn

Dc, dc2tog, dc2tog, dc (4 stitches). Turn

Dc, dc2tog, dc.

Turn. Dc into final stitch



Crochet Reindeer Chocolate Orange Cover

Body:

Round 1: 6 dc into Magic Circle

Round 2: 2dc into each stitch (12 stitches)

Round 3: 1dc into first stitch, 2dc into next stitch, repeat to end (18 stitches)

Round 4: 1dc, into first two stitches, 2dc into next stitch, repeat to end (24 stitches)

Round 5: 1dc into first three stitches, 2dc into next stitch, repeat to end (30 stitches)

Round 6: 1dc into first four stitches, 2dc into next stitch, repeat to end (36 stitches)

Round 7-17: 1dc into each stitch (36 stitches)

Round 18: 1dc into first four stitches, dc2tog, repeat to end (30 stitches)

Round 19: 1dc into first three stitches, dc2tog, repeat to end (24 stitches)

Round 20: 1dc into each stitch (24 stitches)

Fasten off.

Antler 1:

Chain 16

Dc into each stitch. Turn

Slip stitch in 2nd chain from hook, and then sl st into next 8 stitches

Chain 5, dc in 2nd ch from hook. Dc in next 3 st

sl st into next stitch on main branch of antler, then sl st to end.

Fasten off.

Antler 2:

Chain 16

Dc into each stitch. Turn

Slip stitch in 2nd chain from hook, and then sl st into next 4 stitches

Chain 5, dc in 2nd ch from hook. Dc in next 3 st

sl st into next stitch on main branch of antler, then sl st to end.

Fasten off.



Crochet Snowman Stocking Gift Sack

Materials:

- Chunky White Yarn
- Worsted weight yarn in green (or any colour you want for the beanie), and orange for the nose. A small strand of black yarn is also needed for the mouth.
- Size H crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- 1/8 inch ribbon (optional)
- Large snowflake button (or any button you want)
- Two 1/2 inch black buttons for the eyes

Sack Pattern;

Magic Ring, Chain 1 and make 10 SC in ring, join, pull tight, chain 1

Round 2: 2 SC in each stitch around, join, chain 1 (20 SC)

Round 3: SC in each stitch around, join, chain 1 (20 SC)

Round 4: 2 SC in first stitch, SC in next, repeat around, join, chain 1 (30 SC)

Round 5: SC in each stitch around, join, chain 1 (30 SC)

Round 6: 2 SC in first stitch, SC in next 2, repeat around, join, chain 1 (40 SC)

Round 7-15: SC in each stitch around, join, chain 1 (40 SC)

Attach green worsted weight yarn (or whatever you colour you want the beanie to be)

Round 16: SC in each stitch around, join, chain 1

Round 17-19: Front Post SC, Back Post SC, repeat around, join, chain 1 (this creates the ribbed rim of the hat)

Round 20-25: SC in each stitch around, join, fasten off and weave in ends. (40 SC)

With a thin strand of ribbon (I used 1/8 inch wide) OR a strand of yarn, attach yarn pom-pom to one end. With tapestry needle, weave strand over and under the last SC stitches made in round 25. Attach a large snowflake button to the other end of your strand of ribbon. When pulling tight, only pull on the side of the strand with the snowflake. This allows the pom pom to sit on to of the hat when top of sack is closed!

Snowman Nose:

with orange yarn

Chain 5, SC in second chain from hook, HDC in next 2, DC in last. *SC around the back of the DC stitch, continue to slip stitch on the bottom edge of the nose and join to point. *this part is optional.

Stitch nose to front of sack. Add button eyes and sew on a half smile mouth with black yarn and your tapestry needle.



Knitted Christmas Pudding Chocolate Orange Cover



DK YARN

3.5mm knitting needles

Using Brown ~

Cast on 43sts

1st Row: S1, *k1, p1, repeat from * to the last 2sts, k2

2nd Row: S1, *p1, k1, repeat from * to end

Repeat last 2 rows five times more

Change to White ~

Knit 6 rows

19th Row: S1, knit to end

20th Row: S1 purl to last st, K1

Repeat last 2 rows twice more

25th Row: *K2tog, repeat from * to last st, K1

26th Row: P2 tog, to end

Cut yarn, leaving a 'tail' to use for sewing up, draw the end through all stitches, pull up tightly

Add a couple of holy leaves and some red berries ~

Holly leaves – makes 2 leaves joined together

Using green yarn cast on 1 stitch

- Row 1: Knit
- Row 2: Knit 3 times into the stitch (3sts)
- Row 3: Knit front and back into the first stitch, k1, knit front and back into the last stitch (5sts)
- Row 4: Cast off 1 stitch, k3 (4sts)
- Row 5: Cast off 1 stitch, k2 (3sts)
- Row 6: Knit front and back into the first stitch, k1, knit front and back into the last stitch (5sts)
- Row 7: Cast off 1 stitch, k3 (4sts)
- Row 8: Cast off 1 stitch, k2 (3sts)
- Row 9: Slip 1 stitch, k2tog, pass slip stitch over (1st)
- Row 10: Knit 3 times into the stitch (3sts)
- Row 11: Knit front and back into the first stitch, k1, knit front and back into the last stitch (5sts)
- Row 12: Cast off 1 stitch, k3 (4sts)
- Row 13: Cast off 1 stitch, k2 (3sts)
- Row 14: Knit front and back into the first stitch, k1, knit front and back into the last stitch (5sts)
- Row 15: Cast off 1 stitch, k3 (4sts)
- Row 16: Cast off 1 stitch, k2 (3sts)
- Row 17: Slip 1 stitch, k2tog, pass slip stitch over (1st)

Fasten off

Berry

Using red yarn cast on 3 stitches

- Row 1: Knit in the front and back of every stitch (6sts)
- Row 2: Purl
- Row 3: Knit
- Row 4: P2tog three times (3sts)

Cast off

Tie cast on and cast off tails together (this pulls the berry together)

Sew leaves and berry on to the top

Fill with a Terry's Chocolate Orange

Knitted Santa Hat Chocolate Orange Cover

DK YARN

3.5mm knitting needles

Using White ~

Cast on 43sts

Knit 8 rows

Change to Red ~

Work 12 rows in stocking stitch (1row knit, 1 row purl)

Shape the top ~

Row 21: *K5, k2tog, repeat from * to last st, k1 (37sts)

Rows 22, 24, 26, 28, 30: S1, purl to last st, k1

Row 23: *K4, k2tog, repeat from * to last st, k1 (31sts)

Row 25: *K3, k2tog, repeat from * to last st, k1 (25sts)

Row 27: *K2, k2tog, repeat from * to last st, k1 (19sts)

Row 29: *K1, k2tog, repeat from * to last st, k1 (13sts)

Row 31: *K2tog, repeat from * to last st, k1 (7sts)

Cut off yarn, leaving a tail – thread the tail through the remaining 7sts, and pull up tight

Sew up the side seam, using the corresponding colour for each section.

Darn away ends

Add a bobble or a pompom on to the top of the hat

To make a bobble –

Bobble

Using White cast on 3 stitches

Row 1: Knit in the front and back of every stitch (6sts)

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: Knit

Row 4: P2tog three times (3sts)

Cast off

Fill with a Terry's Chocolate Orange



Knitted Snowman Chocolate Orange Cover

DK YARN

3.5mm knitting needles

Using Red ~

Cast on 43sts

Knit 2 rows

Change to White ~

Work 12 rows in stocking stitch (1 row knit, 1 row purl)

Change to Green ~

Knit 4 rows

Work 2 rows in stocking stitch

Shape the top ~

Row 21: *K5, k2tog, repeat from * to last st, k1 (37sts)

Rows 22, 24, 26, 28, 30: S1, purl to last st, k1

Row 23: *K4, k2tog, repeat from * to last st, k1 (31sts)

Row 25: *K3, k2tog, repeat from * to last st, k1 (25sts)

Row 27: *K2, k2tog, repeat from * to last st, k1 (19sts)

Row 29: *K1, k2tog, repeat from * to last st, k1 (13sts)

Row 31: *K2tog, repeat from * to last st, k1 (7sts)

Cut off yarn, leaving a tail – thread the tail through the remaining 7sts, and pull up tight

Sew up the side seam, using the corresponding colour for each section.

Darn away ends

Add a bobble or a pompom on to the top of the hat

To make a bobble –

Bobble

Using red yarn cast on 3 stitches

Row 1: Knit in the front and back of every stitch (6sts)

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: Knit

Row 4: P2tog three times (3sts)

Cast off

Add a face ~

For the eyes – sew on two small black buttons (or use a length of black yarn)

For the mouth – use a length of black yarn and make 3 or 4 running stitches

For the nose – using a length of orange yarn ~

Cast on 4sts

K4,

K2tog, k2tog,

K2tog,

Fasten off

Sew on the nose, using the cast on and cast off tails

Fill with a Terry's Chocolate Orange



Knitted Elf Hat Chocolate Orange Cover

DK YARN

3.5mm knitting needles

Using White yarn ~

Cast on 43sts

1st Row: S1, *k1, p1, repeat from * to the last 2sts, k2

2nd Row: S1, *p1, k1, repeat from * to end

Repeat last 2 rows three times more

Add in Red yarn (don't cut off the White yarn) ~

Work 2 rows in stocking stitch (1row knit, 1 row purl) in red

Work 2 rows in stocking stitch (1row knit, 1 row purl) in white

Work 2 rows in stocking stitch (1row knit, 1 row purl) in red

Work 2 rows in stocking stitch (1row knit, 1 row purl) in white

Work 2 rows in stocking stitch (1row knit, 1 row purl) in red

Work 2 rows in stocking stitch (1row knit, 1 row purl) in white

Work 2 rows in stocking stitch (1row knit, 1 row purl) in red

Continue in the 2 colour stripe sequence ~

Shape the top ~

Row 23: *K5, k2tog, repeat from * to last st, k1 (37sts)

Row 24: Purl across row

Row 25: Knit across row

Row 26: Purl across row

Row 27: *K4, k2tog, repeat from * to last st, k1 (31sts)

Row 28: Purl across row

Row 29: Knit across row

Row 30: Purl across row

Row 31: *K3, k2tog, repeat from * to last st, k1 (25sts)

Row 32: Purl across row

Row 33: Knit across row

Row 34: Purl across row

Row 35: *K2, k2tog, repeat from * to last st, k1 (19sts)

Row 36: Purl across row

Row 37: Knit across row

Row 38: Purl across row

Continued on next page

Knitted Elf Hat Continued

Row 39: *K1, k2tog, repeat from * to last st, k1 (13sts)

Row 40: Purl across row

Row 41: Knit across row

Row 42: Purl across row

Row 43: Knit across row

Row 44: Purl across row

Row 45: Knit across row

Row 46: Purl across row

Row 47: *K2tog, repeat from * to last st, k1 (7sts)

Row 48: Purl across row

Row 49: Knit across row

Row 50: Purl across row

Row 51: Knit across row

Row 52: Purl across row

Row 53: Knit across row

Row 54: Purl across row

Row 55: K2tog, k2tog, k2tog, k1 (4sts)

Row 56: P2tog, p2tog

Row 57: K2tog (2sts)

Cut off both yarns

Fasten off

Join seam

Darn away ends

Add a pom-pom or jingle bell
